## She Is Wed in the Brick Church to Aide of du Pont Museum

Mrs. Currie Mathews Cabot of Green Plains, North Post Office, Va., widow of F. Higginson Cabot, was married here yesterday morning to A. Chapin Rogers of West Chester, Pa.

The ceremony was performed in the Brick Presbyterian Church by the Rev. Stanley E. Niebruegge.

The bride is the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Wilbur Knox Mathews of New York. Her husband, who is with the Henry Francis du Pont Museum at Winterthur, Del., is the son of Mrs. Hamilton Fish of Washington, wife of the former Representative from New York. Mr. Rogers is the son also of William Beverley Rogers of Garrison, N. Y.

Through his late paternal grandmother, the former Miss Susan Le Roy Fish, the bridegroom is descended from the late Hamilton Fish, who was Secretary of State under President Grant.
